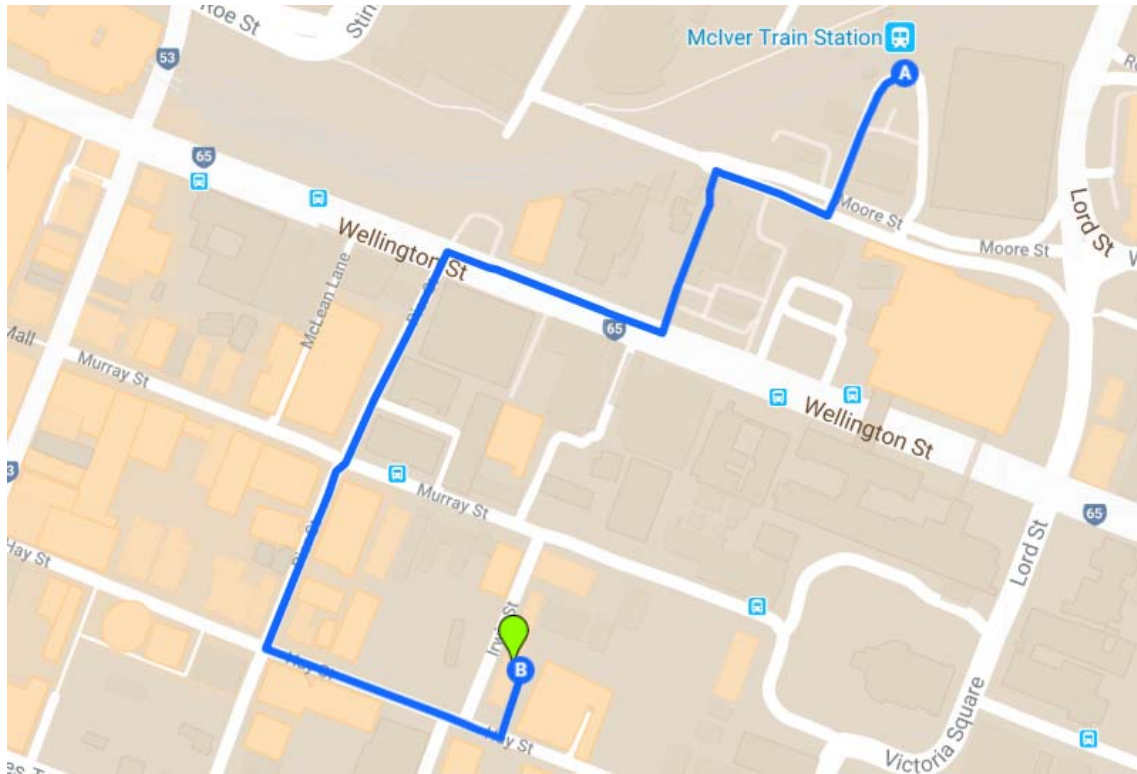


1. Location of Venue

The Westin Perth is located at 480 Hay Street, Perth and is within the Central Business District (CBD). The two closest train stations to the Conference venue are Elizabeth Quay Train Station (1.12 Km away) and Perth Train Station (965m away). The closest bus station is the Perth Bus Station (965m away). Note, within the CBD there is free public transport. For more information, please [click here](#).



2. Airport and Transport

AIRPORT



Perth Airport is located 12 kilometres from The Westin Perth in Perth's City Centre and is approximately a 20 minute drive. The following transport options are available from the airport to Perth's City Centre.

BUS



A regular public bus service operates between all Perth Airport Terminals and Perth city. [Click here](#) to view more information on this service, including maps and timetables. To view pricing please visit www.transperth.wa.gov.au/tickets-fares.

TAXI



A taxi trip from the airport terminals to Perth will take 20 minutes depending on the time of day. The journey will cost approximately A\$30.00 – A\$50.00. All taxis are meter operated by time and distance and operate twenty-four hours a day. Taxis indicate they are vacant by illuminating their sign on the roof. Taxis are easily accessible from the airport; there are ranks outside both the international and domestic terminals.

UBER



An Uber is approximately A\$35.00 from the Airport to Perth's City Centre. Please note your pickup location depends on your terminal and ride option.

Follow the below steps if you would like to utilise an Uber service:

1. Download the [Uber](#) App on your mobile device by searching 'Uber' in iTunes or Google Play.
2. Create an account and enter your details as directed.
3. Please wait until you have collected your luggage and are ready to leave the airport before requesting your ride using the Uber app.
4. Exit the terminal - The pickup location will depend on the type of vehicle you have selected. Please refer to the instructions below to find out where to meet your driver.
5. Look for your vehicle and driver – if you can't find your driver, contact them through the app.

Rideshares:

There are dedicated rideshare pick-up bays within easy walking distance of each terminal. Simply follow the directions on the terminal signage to the nearest rideshare pick-up bay. [Click here](#) to view the location on a map.

3. Parking



The Westin Perth has valet parking for A\$55 per day.

4. Registration Process

The registration desk will be located within the Level 2 foyer. All participants must visit the registration desk to collect their Conference materials and name badge before gaining access to the Conference. The Conference will begin promptly at 11:00am on Wednesday 5 June 2019 after the Pre-Conference Commercialisation Forum. All delegates are requested to be seated in Ballroom 2 by 10:55am.

We encourage you to register onsite as early as possible to allow for easy access to the opening of the Conference.

6. Pre-Conference Commercialisation Forum

There will be a Pre-Conference Commercialisation Forum which is included in your full Conference registration on Wednesday 5 June 2019 at 8:30am prior to SOTS 2019 commencing.

The theme of the Forum is 'WA Innovation Unearthed – Entrepreneurial Stories of Feats and Failure' and includes a keynote by Joanne Boag from Global Kinetics Corporation. The Forum also includes personal interviews, where Charlie Gunningham speaks to WA entrepreneurs about the highs and lows of commercialisation.

7. Poster Sessions

Posters will be located on Level 2 in Ballroom 3 and the Level 2 Foyer with the catering stations. All delegates are encouraged to visit the posters and meet with the authors during the catering breaks.
